- ❖ The textbooks purchased last year were a great help to both Grade 8 and Grade 12 students who wrote their exams.

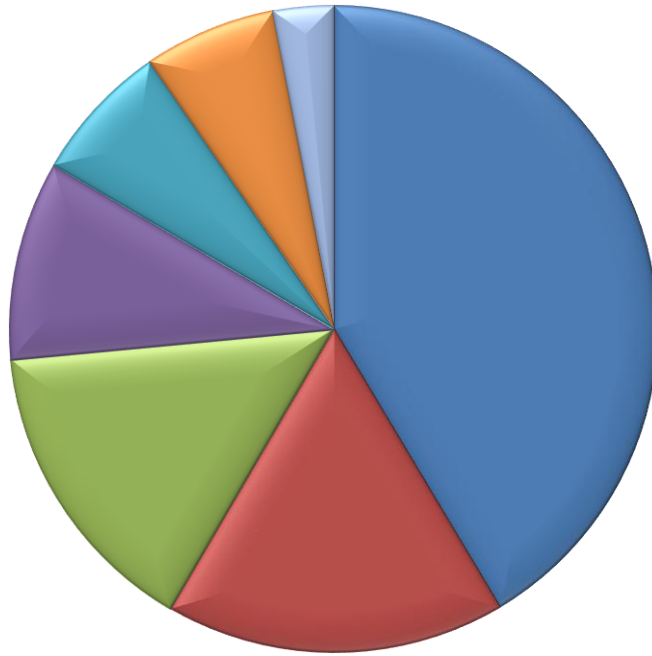

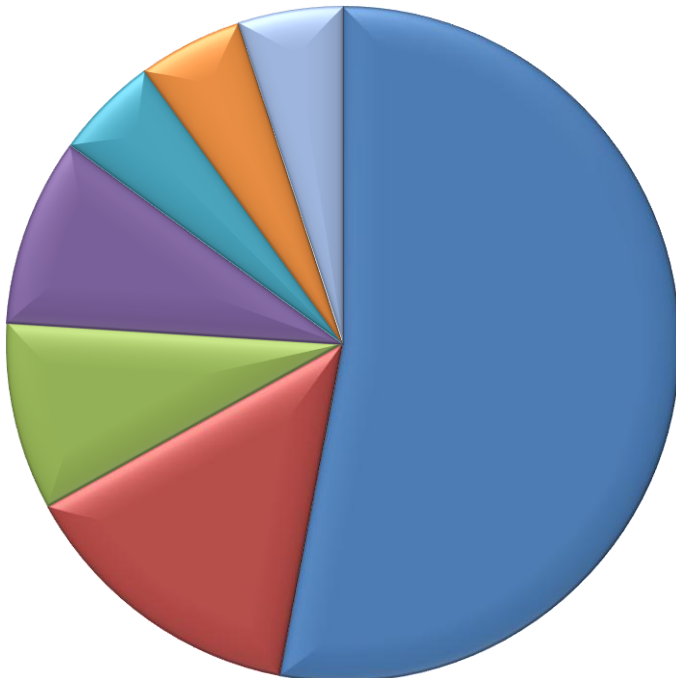
