


# Sud Academy Update

After graduating from secondary level, Guot wishes to do an agricultural course so that he may go back to his home village in South Sudan to do farming projects. Guot is grateful to the supporters of Sud Academy for their generous giving that allows the school to educate students such as him. He says "I would kindly ask them to keep up with their care in order that these young ones may also have an opportunity to go complete their education.
